Sulekha Plan Monitoring System for
Decentralized Planning, Kerala**

The Sulekha Plan Monitoring system was conceived by the Local Self Government. Department the State Planning Board and Information Kerala Mission as a comprehensive e-governance initiative for the formulation of the nearly 2 lakh annual decentralized plan projects of local governments, their appraisal and approval, and monitoring. Sulekha, the Information Kerala Mission was started for the e-governance in 1223 local governments in Kerala in the context of decentralization of powers to the local governments. The State Government devolved powers, funds and

functionaries to the local governments in a massive way since 1997. Projects for nearly 40% of the plan funds of the State (about Rs. 1500 crore a year) are now prepared and implemented by the local governments. The projects are prepared locally based on local needs and hence more accepted. The Local Self Government Department and the State Planning Board takes full ownership of the project and provides full leadership and support in implementing this e-governance initiative. The IT Department / IT Mission also facilitates co-location of servers at the Data Centre, and the connectivity through KSWAN/State Information Infrastructure.
